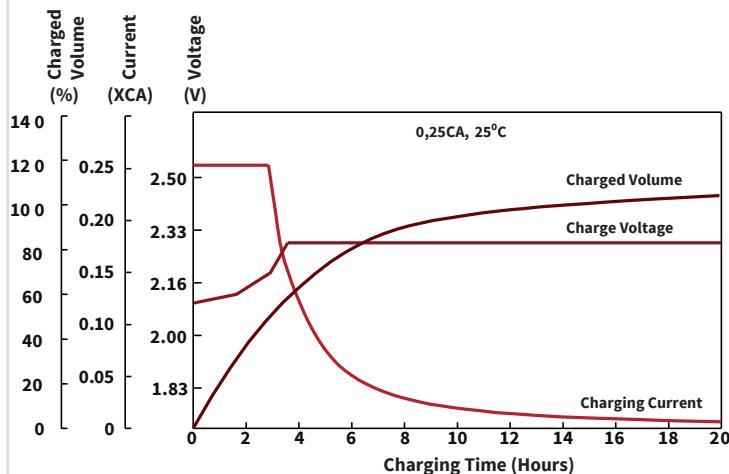

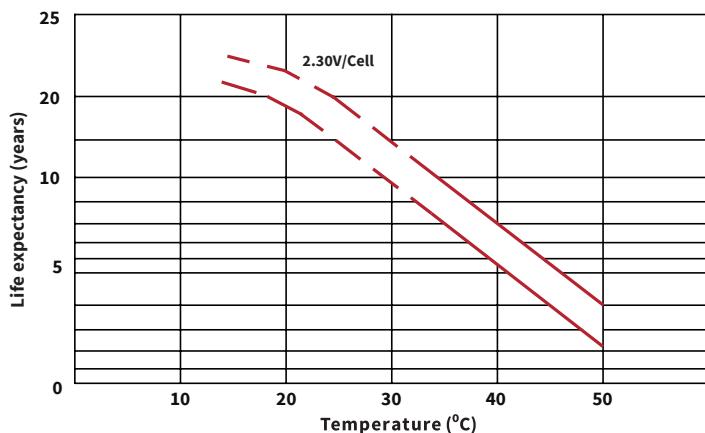
Charge characteristics




Discharge characteristics
